Action Surrey - Surrey Healthy Homes

The Surrey Healthy Homes Partnership comprises of over 30 public, private and community organisations and was established in 2012. It is managed by Action Surrey and has continued to flourish thanks to funding received from the Department of Health, Warm Homes Healthy People Fund. The purpose of the fund aimed to reduce health related problems and winter deaths through energy efficiency improvements to housing and through the provision of cold weather services.



To date, the project has consisted of a major County-wide communication campaign encouraging the up-take of insulation and other energy efficiency improvements, regional emergency cold weather measures; such as 28 boiler services and over 30 boiler replacements fitted by Thameswey Maintenance Services Ltd; Keep Warm Keep Well Kits; localised meals-on-wheels scheme and GP taxi vouchers; localised Park Home assessments; localised Community Connectors scheme; county-wide loft clearance service scheme and a Surviving Winter Fund.
