Recent Projects

17 New Apartments, Ascot

We were commissioned by Kebbell Developments to provide a Renewable Energy Options Appraisal, Energy Statement, SAP calculations and Code for Sustainable Homes assessments to support its planning application for the construction of 17 apartments in Ascot.

Mixed Retail and Residential Development, Rickmansworth
