## Dear Resident,

In the near future we will be undertaking engineering works on the A320 Victoria Way that may affect you. Contained in this leaflet you will find details of the where our works will be carried out and how this will affect the access to the area.


### When:

11<sup>th</sup> May – 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 [11<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> May (p) to (o), 1<sup>st</sup> June to 12<sup>th</sup> June (o) to (n)]

## Works:

During the period of these works we will be excavating a trench across Victoria Way to install district heating pipework. This will be carried out in two sections to minimize the impact on traffic access to residents and businesses




From the 11<sup>th</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> May southbound vehicles will be diverted via Lockfield Drive, northbound traffic will be unaffected.

From the 1<sup>st</sup> June to 12<sup>th</sup> June northbound vehicles will be diverted via Goldsworth Rd/Forge End, southbound traffic will be unaffected. Church Street West and Forge End will become one-way northbound only.

There will inevitably be some traffic disruption associated with this, for which we apologize in advance.



## Why are these works being carried out?

We are extending our district heating network to provide essential infrastructure for the Woking town centre. This is in order to deliver low-carbon environmentally sustainable energy supplies to Town Centre residents and businesses.

This project is the first phase of a wider district heating infrastructure project running along Forge End, Church Street West, Goldsworth Rd and Poole Rd.



## Disruption:

Vehicles – traffic access along the A320 to and from Victoria Arch will be affected, and bus routes will be diverted to avoid the works.

Construction/Delivery – Vehicles accessing SRM site will still have limited site access via the north Gate

We thank you for your understanding during these works as we help to develop Woking as one of the UKs leading low-carbon communities.
