Dear Resident,


In the near future we will be undertaking engineering works in **Forge End** that may affect you. Contained in this leaflet you will find details of the where our works will be carried out and how this will affect the access to the area.

When:

3rd August, 2020 – 25th September [(K) to (N)]

Works:

During the period of these works we will be excavating a trench along the Northbound carriageway to install district heating pipework. This will be carried out in two sections (K) to (L), (L) to (N) to facilitate access to businesses in the area.

Continuing the diversion for Phase 2, from the 3rd

August southbound entry from Victoria Way to Forge End will be diverted via Lockfield Drive to access via Goldsworth Rd. Access from Church Street West and Forge End will continue one-way northbound only.

There will inevitably be some traffic disruption associated with this, for which we apologize in advance.



RAFFIC SIGNALS TO BE SWITCHED OUT ON JUNCTION






Vehicular access into carparks along this route will be maintained where necessary, but we would ask residents to park elsewhere where possible to facilitate any works being carried out across a carpark entrance/exit.

Why are these works being carried out?

We are extending our district heating network to provide essential infrastructure for the Woking town centre. This is in order to deliver low-carbon environmentally sustainable energy supplies to Town Centre residents and businesses.

This (N) to (K) is the Third phase of a wider district heating infrastructure project running along Forge End, Church Street West, Goldsworth Rd and Poole Rd.



Disruption:

Vehicles – traffic access to Church Street West and Forge End will be affected, and bus routes will be diverted to avoid the works.

Construction/Delivery – Vehicles accessing sites site will still have site access via Church Street West
